

Campsite rules

- Úlfjótavatn is a family campsite. Guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian. Bookings without an adult will be denied
- Please make a booking online before setting up the camp. If not possible, contact the camp staff on arrival.
- Please pay for electricity before plugging in. Each socket is only for one unit (tent/vehicle). Be careful not to overload the socket.
- Cars must be parked in Parking zones, not the camping area.
- Vehicle traffic should be kept to a minimum and restricted to arrivals and departures, No vehicle traffic is permitted between 23:30-07:00.
- Speed limit on the campsite roads is 15 km/h.
- Quiet time is 23:30-07:00.
Music, parties, loud talking or other unnecessary noise is not tolerated during this period.
- Dogs are to be kept on a leash and cleaned up after. Animals that cause disturbance or fear to other guests must leave the campsite.
- Fires are only allowed in designated fire pits. Do not place disposable grills directly on the ground. Be careful when using grills and gas appliances.
- Being overly under the influence of alcohol is strictly forbidden.
- Smoking or vaping is not allowed in common areas, buildings, or at the location of program activities.
- Please tidy the guest kitchen after use.
- Please do not cause damage to nature, campsite buildings or equipment.
- Please clean your area before leaving and help us recycle. All waste should go into the correct bins in the guest kitchen or at our main recycling center by the service center.
- A fishing permit is included in the camping fee. Please register online before fishing and follow the rules as described.
- Using the Center's canoes and boats is strictly forbidden.
- Using personal boats, canoes or kayaks on the lake is allowed, however use of motors is forbidden.
- Wastewater tanks should be emptied only at the designated area (see map or ask the campsite staff for more information).
- Please contact the campsite staff if you notice something broken or missing.
- Failure to follow these rules will lead to the termination of stay at the campsite.
